Boat Storage Center Afloat at Russells Point

Huntsville, Ohio – Community Storage & Properties, Ltd. (COMSTOR) announced that construction will begin on a new 30-unit boat storage center near Indian Lake, Ohio.

The COMSTOR Boat Storage project is located on St. Rt. 235 N near Honda Transmission Russells Point, Ohio. The project expansion will include a new 30' x 180' mini storage building and a 70' x 180' Boat Storage Center complete with lights, fencing, and security details.

Project development began in 2003 with the construction on two smaller mini storage buildings and planning for future development continues. "The popularity of Indian Lake as a summer destination has created a great interest in personalized boat storage units. The new building touts extra space around the perimeter to allow for boat transportation on trailers and larger vehicles. Units can be accessed 24 hours a day – 7 days a week.
